

INTERAGENCY COMMISSION ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION
Capital Improvement Program

NOTICE

This Notice is given by Robert A. Gorrell, Executive Director of the Interagency Commission on School Construction, acting pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the “Governor”) dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended from time to time (the “State of Emergency”), and the Order of the Governor dated June 19, 2020 entitled “Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements,” as may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

The Interagency Commission on School Construction is extending the requirement under Md. Code Ann., Educ. § 5-303(j)(3) and Code of Maryland Regulation (“COMAR”) 14.39.02.09 Rescinding Funding Approval to extend the date by which a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) project must be under contract. For any project under these provisions that will expire during the State of Emergency, the deadline by which the project must be under contract is hereby extended to June 30, 2021. Any effect of statute or regulation inconsistent with the foregoing is hereby suspended.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until June 30, 2021.
