School Mapping Data Standards Draft

BALTIMORE, MD - The School Mapping Data Program, established in 2024 by House Bill 472 (2024 Md. Laws, Ch. 167), was created to establish State funding eligibility to support Local Education Agencies (LEAs) in producing school mapping data for each public PreKindergarten through Grade 12 school, including public charter schools, in order to provide electronic information for first responders in case of emergencies at a school and for facilities management, funding, and oversight personnel. The School Mapping Data Standards are currently under development to support the creation of uniform data across LEAs; a draft of these standards and accompanying sample template files are now available for review and comment.
